run untill 7 p.m. then came too
on port tack furled all but
M. staysail and fore staysail
No Leat.

Tues 5th

Fore part moderate with
squalls of rain wind S. course
E. Latter part blowing
strong from S. to S.E. course
E. and E by N.
Leat 39-20 Lon 171-13

Wed 6th

Fore part strong breeze S.W.
course E. by S. squally
Latter part wind S.W. course
E. by S.
Leat 39-20 Lon 168-00

Thu 7th

Fore part light airs from S.W. to W.
untill 9 a.m. then calm course E by S.
Latter part wind from E. to S.E.
with some rain ship on star-tack
No Leat.

Fri 8th

Fore part wind S.E. strong and squally
ship on star-tack
Latter part the same as fore part
Leat 39-52 Lon 163-52

Sat 9th

Fore part moderate wind from
S.E. to E. at 8 wore ship.
Latter part some fog wind E.
ship on port tack
Leat 39-21 Lon 162-26

Sunday 10th

Fore part fine light airs from E.
ship on port tack
Latter part wind E.N.E. ship
on port tack
No Leat.

Mon 11th

Fore part wind from E. to E.N.E.
ship on port tack
Latter part quite a strong breeze
E. ship on port tack
Leat 42-10 Lon 150-39

Tues 12th

Fore part wind N.E. course E. by S.
when we saw head it
Latter part light wind E.N.E.
with rain and fog
No Leat
