SATURDAY, MARCH 23, 1889

Bark California at Honolulu

March 19th

Begins with fresh Breeze from N. East at 3 PM took 11 Deserters from the jail & took them on board. The ship at 4 PM got the ship under weigh & started out of the Honolulu under topsails stowed the anchors & ends

Sunday Mar 20th

Laying off & on Honolulu with strong Breeze from N. East waiting to catch some more deserters

Monday Mar 21st

Begins with strong Breeze from N. East ship laying off & on Honolulu

Tuesday Mar 22nd

Strong N. East Trades ship laying off & on Honolulu

Wednesday Mar 23rd

Began with strong N. East Trades at 4 PM. Capt came on board with two boat stores, three men forward. came off in the tug. left the ship off to the westward under topsails

SUNDAY, MARCH 24, 1889

Onboard Bk California bound for the Arctic

Thursday March 24th

This day. Begins with strong N. East Trades steering down between the Islands of Oahu & Kauai carried away the main top Galant yard sent it down & began to get out a new one the Islands & our sail seen

Friday Mar 25th

Begins with strong N. East Trades steering N. West under topsails employed in rigging main top Galant yard

Saturday March 26th Lat 28.20 Long 161.16 West

To day strong N. East Trades steering N. West sent up main top Galant yard

Sunday Mar 27th Lat 31.20 Long 162.18 West

To day strong N. East Trades steering N. West with all sail set

Monday Mar 28th Lat 34.00 Long 163.02 West

Begins with fresh Breeze from West steering N. West employed in building of crew deck
