Wednesday March 30th

This day light variable winds with
rain steering N.W. by North

Thursday March 31st No Observations

This day fresh breeze from S.W. steering
N.W. by North thick fog

Friday April 1st No Observations

Begins with strong breeze from S.W. with
rain latter part wind lighter steering N.W. by North
with all sail set

Saturday April 2nd Lat 45.55 North Long 168.56 West
Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. steering
N.W. by North latter breeze on & hauls the
N.W. that heading N.W. East under lower
top sails & courses

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TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 1889

On board Bk California

Sunday Monday April 3rd Lat 46.30 N Long 167.29 West
This day strong breeze from North
heading N.W. that

Monday Tuesday April 4th Lat 48.27 North Long 170.09 West
First part light breeze from E. latter hauls the
S part strong N.W. by North with light sails
furled

Tuesday April 5th Lat 50.49 N Long 171.15 West
Begins with strong breeze from S.W. then hauls
to S.W. & moderates steering N.W. by North

Wednesday April 6th

Begins with strong breeze from
S.W. steering N.W. by North at 6 A.M. sighted the
Island of Sequam ship in the straits of 72 fms
two boats went in fishing got 40 or 50 codfish
got on board at 6 P.M. kept the ship off steering
N.W. 1/2 North
