Thursday April 7<sup>th</sup>  
To day fresh Breeze from S East with  
Rain steams N.W. to North with all sail  
out sent up the Crews mast

Friday April 8<sup>th</sup> Lat 55.41 to one Long  
Begins with light Breeze to N West later  
Breezed on the moderate Gale ship heading  
to Westward

Saturday April 9<sup>th</sup> Lat 55.45 to Long 174.00 West  
This day strong Breeze from N West heading  
to West

Sunday April 10 No Observations  
Begins with strong Breeze from S West  
thick & misty weather steering to N West  
later shifted to heading N.W. by West

Monday April 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 58.50 to Long 176.55 West  
Strong Breeze from from Southward steering  
N.W. by West

Tuesday April 12<sup>th</sup> Lat 60.20 to Long 178.46 West  
Wind from S West steams to N West passed  
the Schooner Altam at 1 PM saw some scattering  
Ice

made the  
ice

Wednesday April 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 61.38  
This day fresh Breeze from S West  
steering to N West at 2 M came up to the Ice  
Gaming with the Bk Mar. Balis

Thursday April 14<sup>th</sup> Lat 61.25 West  
fresh Breeze from S W at 7 AM Ice close  
in on the ship put all sail on the ship  
to get out but wind died out & we was  
fast rigged the Ruder Tackles the Mast  
Balis in the Ice

Friday April 15<sup>th</sup>  
Ship in the Ice no wind  
the Mar. Balis got out the edges of the Ice  
about 1 mile off two other sails in sight  
saw the land Cape Navarin bearing N West  
distance 60 miles
