Onboard Bk. California

May Monday 9th

This day wind strong from north with rain & snow ship in ice the men from Sea Breeze still onboard & ship in sight leak about the arm

Tuesday May 10th Lat 64.04 Long 127.27

This day fine weather light breeze from north ship in the ice the little more slack the men from the Sea Breeze went to their ship the ship leak a little on the deck

Wednesday May 11th Lat 64.08

Began with light breeze from S.W. then hauled to north at 3 A.M. hauled to East & blowed on the gale with snow & rain at 4 1/2 P.M. broke the eye bolt on starboard side of ship where the Ruddy Jack hooked in the ice jammed the Ruddy over to Port put away the ice & got it amid ships again

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TUESDAY, APRIL 9, 1889

Onboard Bk. California

Thursday May 12th

This day strong breeze from north boat ship in the ice ice inclined to open some the same ship in sight

Friday May 13th

This day fresh breeze from N. East to East ship in ice emptying it in stowing off the hold & filling small casks with salt water stowed down the boxes of Bread & Sails that was had on deck & sails in sight

Saturday May 14th

Began with light breeze from East to port with some rain ship in ice Cooper setting up stocks

Sunday May 15th

This day fine weather light breeze from north ship in ice
