Thursday May 19th Lat 64.03 Long 176.44.0
 This day light breeze from
 N. N. West with quite a swell from S West
 ship in ice. Shot a Seal. V got him
 the land in sight. Ice inclined to close up

Friday May 20th Lat 64.02 Long 176.45
 This day fresh breeze from N. N. West
 with some swell from S West ship in ice
 the land in sight & came close

Saturday May 21st This day fine weather light
 breeze from N West. Ship in the ice
 the same ships in sight & land

Sunday May 22nd To day wind from
 S West the North snowing all day
 ship in ice

Monday May 23rd Lat 63.53 Long
 To day light breeze with
 lots of snow from N West. Ship in
 the ice. The same ships all in sight

Tuesday May 24th Lat 63.46 Long 176.52 West
 To day fine weather fresh breeze
 from North. Ship in ice all the other
 ships in sight
