Thursday May 24th Lat 63° 45' Long 176° 34'
 To day fine weather & light
 Breeze from S East Ship in the Ice
 the same Ship in night

Friday May 25th Lat 63° 46' Long 176° 48'
 To day fine Breeze from S East
 Ship in Ice the Steamer Orea passed
 us working through the Ice to North

Saturday May 26th light Breeze from
 S East with fog & Rain & Snow
 Ship in the Ice the same Ship in
 night

Onboard Bark California

Sunday May 27th
 This day fresh Breeze from
 S East trying to work the
 Ship through the Ice the North & East
 at 10 P.M. Ice slackened up and weched
 the North and the same Ship in night

Monday May 28th
 This day nearly a Gale
 from S East Ship worked the North
 and at 4 P.M. Breeze on more & Ice
 closed up more fast all the Sails again

Tuesday May 29th
 To day fresh Breeze from
 S East Ice quite open the S East of
 Ship with a heavy swell from S East
 Ship worked the North and through the
 slack Ice and founding quite fast in
 the Ice latter part Ice closed up again
 & the swell went down and fine other
 ships in night
