Onboard Bark California

Wednesday June 8th

This day strong Breeze from N. East Ship working up the Phoebe Bay at 3 P.M. and the Anchor off East Head of Phoebe Bay in ten fathoms where the Bark Reindeer anchored about the same time at 2 P.M. the wind hauled to S.W. & the Ice came in had to flee in short order

Thursday June 9th

This day calm The Ice came in around the ship and the Orca came in & went out again the Reindeer at anchor

Friday June 10th

This day Calm at 2 P.M. took the Anchor & towed the Ship out and anchored again the Steamers Belvedere & Chalak came in & anchored the Place quite clear of Ice

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WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Saturday June 11th

Light Airs from S.W. at anchor the two Steamers went out to the Westward the Reindeer went out got off shore & anchored again the other vessels in sight to South

Sunday June 12th

This day fresh Breeze from N. East the Ice came in to the Ship had to get under way & worked to Eastward at 3 P.M. the Ship backed into a cake of Ice & broke another Rudder Pintle & broke three spokes out of the wheel & the forward Port

Monday June 13th

This day fresh Breeze from N. East and foggy at 6 A.M. came to anchor off Indian Point in 8 fathoms top water the Reindeer & Mon Bailes & the Knobel & Sea Breeze came in to anchor
