Onboard Bark California

Tuesday June 14th

To day fine weather
wind from North took in the Rudder
to put on some new Paints the
Cooper of the Seabreeze came aboard
to fix it the Bark Hunter & Adam
Barker Helen Mor & Schooner Trevelin
came in to Anchor

Wednesday June 15th

To day light Breeze from
North employed in fixing Rudder at
4 PM finished it & put in in
but could not get it clear down
the other ships all flatted in short
mud to get clear of the ice

Thursday June 16th

This day fresh Breeze
from S East the Rudder worked too
hard had to take it out again &
fix off the two lower points at 1 PM put
it out again & was taking it up to hang it
& the boat came out & lost the Rudder got
two Grapnels from Adam Barker & plied for it
at 6 PM got it took it up & hung it & it
worked all right

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FRIDAY, APRIL 19, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Friday June 17th

To day fresh Breeze from N
at Anchor at Indian Point four other ships
here & Schooner Alton

Saturday June 18th

This day light Breeze from
S West at 3 PM the ice came in & we had
to get under weigh & go out the other four
ships & Schooner all went out

Sunday June 19th

To day fresh Breeze from
West trying to work the South out of the
ice at 5 PM wind died out at 6 PM light
Breeze from S East right at St Lawrence
Island bearing S East & other ships in
sight

Monday June 20th

To day light Breeze
from S East & foggy ship in heavy
scattering ice trying to work the South
St Lawrence Island in sight & four
sail when it was clear
