

1892 SATURDAY, APRIL 20, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Tuesday June 21st

To day light Breeze from N. East & thick fog ship in ice trying to work the South at 5 PM cleared up saw it dead of open water the S. East steered for it at 8 PM got out of the ice saw one sail to N. West in the ice, saw the Island of St. Lawrence latter part steered of S West

Wednesday June 22nd

This day fresh Breeze from North steering to S West at 10 AM passed the land of St. Lawrence Island saw the Schooner Rosario at anchor there steered off the South down by the West end of the Island then S East

Thursday June 23rd

This day fresh Breeze from N. East steering S. E. at with all sail set at 3 PM sighted the Island of St. Mathews bearing S S West by Compass distant 60 miles

1892 SUNDAY, APRIL 21, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Friday June 24th Lat 52.50 North Long 169.56 West

To day fresh Breeze with some fog from N. East steering S. E. by East with all sail set not anything seen

Saturday June 25th Lat 58.20 Long 168.39 W

This day light Breeze from North to West steering from S. E. by East to S by East with all sail set and Sun back

Sunday June 26th Lat 56.50 Long 168.47

To day light Breeze from West to North at 4 AM sighted the Isles of St. Paul & St. George steering for St. George bearing East by Compass at 9 AM distant 10 miles two ship heading to N. East with all sail set not anything seen in the whole line

Monday June 27th

To day light Breeze from N. East heading N. West the two Islands sight at 9 PM sighted a whole ship at 9 AM ship heading S East
