

MONDAY, APRIL 22, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Tuesday June 28th To day begins with fresh breeze from North with some fog at 10 AM cleared up heading NW then game of wits Mr Bk Mr Bailles saw Timbacks

Wednesday June 29th Lat 52.50 Long 169.40 To day fresh breeze from North heading E. at 7 AM raised two Right Whales lowered four Boats & chased until 2 PM come onboard Whales went to the windward The Mr Bailles with Boats down chasing other whales at 4 PM raised one Right Whale lowered the Boats without success

Thursday June 30th Lat 52.43 Long 169.59 To day fresh breeze from N. West started of the boat until 3 PM luff of the wind at 4 PM hauled heading S West The Mr Bailles in sight & Timbacks at 8 PM sighted the Is. of St Paul bearing S by West

TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 1889

Onboard Bark California

Friday July 1st Lat 52.35 Long 169.09 To day light breeze from West heading SSW to SS. at noon sighted the Is. of St Paul bearing SSW at 6 PM hauled heading NW by West the land bearing S by Compass saw one sail & Timbacks

Saturday July 2nd Lat 52.30 Long 169.40 M This day light breeze from South steering N by West & N by West at 4 PM raised Right Whales long Naps off at 6 PM lowered 4 Boats without success spoke an English Man of War

Sunday July 3rd

To day fresh breeze from N. S. West at 4 AM raised Right Whales by windward at 7 lowered 4 Boats the 2 Boat struck turned him up at noon took him along side at 3 PM commenced to cut at 9 finished cut aways saw as many as 10 different whales one man slightly hurt by the whale sent on the head
