Monday Aug 1st Lat 58.05 Long 169.50
To day fresh Breeze with wind
fogg from West on different tack saw
Jimbarks & tower ship

Tuesday Aug 2nd Lat 57.40 Long 169.50
This day light Breeze with
fogg squalls from West spoke the
Belvedere & St Barstow

Wednesday Aug 3rd
This day fresh Breeze
with fogg from West ship on different
tacks spoke the Reincher

Thursday Aug 4th
This day wind from
N West with much fogg saw two sails
& the Island of St George

Friday Aug 5th
To day fresh Breeze
from West with fogg not anything seen
