Thursday Aug 11th Lat 62.35 Long 167.20
To day fresh breeze with foggy
heading to Northward saw one sail

Friday Aug 12th Lat 63.40 Long 165.20
fresh breeze from N West West
heading from N West East to N N W
at 3 PM tacked headed to South at 6
PM tacked to North at 10 PM
sighted the land Cape Horn

Saturday Aug 13th off & on the
land to the East of Sledge Island
got six Boat loads of Wood

Sunday Aug 14th fresh
To day fresh breeze with
run foggy gained the Schooner La Nina
at 10 PM sighted the land Cape
Prince of Wales & Diomedes

Monday Aug 15th
To day fresh breeze
from S S East to S S W at 2 PM
Diomedes bearing N N W by 100 miles
of N N W 20 miles came in track
