S. S. East with fog at 4 P.M. sighted
the land fair East Cape

Wednesday Aug 17th
To day strong Breeze
V. foggy from S. S. East lying
to work the South

Thursday Aug 18th
Strong Breeze & foggy
from S. S. East hear the bells
saw the land East Cape lying to
work up to it

Friday Aug 19th
Fresh Breeze from
S. S. East & foggy by shells from S
arriving up to East Cape at 10 P.M.
came to anchor in 12 fathoms water

SUNDAY, MAY 5, 1889

Saturday Aug 20th
At anchor at Whalan
East Cape done some trading at 11 A.M.
took the anchor and started off boat
with light Breeze from S. S. East at
3 P.M. wind died out

Sunday Aug 21st
To day nearly calm
& thick foggy later light Breeze from N. N. West

Monday Aug 22nd
To day strong Breeze
& misty from N. N. West heading N. N. East
at 10 A.M. sighted the land Cape
Thompson

Tuesday Aug 23rd light Breeze from
South steering W. N. West at noon forced
point light at 4 P.M. died out calm
at 8 got light Breeze from N. N. West heading
to the West bent new sails

Wednesday Aug 24th Lat 69.00 Long 169.00
To day light Breeze from N. N. West heading
to the West
