& Sea Ranger in sight with Boats down

Monday Sept 5th Lat 71.35 Long 174.18
To day strong Breeze from West
The Banding Billow & Sea Ranger
& Mermanid in sight & Herald
Island bearing S by South by
Compass saw the Banding Billow
take a whale we saw 5 different
whales all to windward no chance

THURSDAY, MAY 9, 1889

Tuesday Sept 6th No Observations
To day strong Breeze with some squalls
from West & West the Island bearing
S by West the Sea Ranger & Mermanid
in sight & Banding Billow the Triton
& Sea Ranger saw her take a whale

Wednesday Sept 7th Lat 71.25 Long 174.05
To day fresh Breeze from N & West
all the above ships whaling and had
our Boats down twice with great success
whales all going quick to windward
spoke the Triton the Island in sight
bearing S by West

Thursday Sept 8th
This day fresh Breeze
from N & West ship cruising about the Sel
saw two whales no chance going to
windward saw the Sea Ranger & Triton
& Mermanid with Boats down saw the
latter take a whale Herald Island in
sight Began S by West distant
20 miles
