from N. East working the midwater
with all sail set found the A Borker

Tuesday Sept 27th Lat 71.43 Long 111.55

To day strong Breef from
N. East at 6 PM raised a
whale close to the ice strip of young
ice at 11 PM took him Le B at 8 PM
took him along side got ready &
cut him in at 1 PM finished cleared
away the dead 18 ships in sight
spoke the Hunter

Wednesday Sept 28th

Strong Breef from
N. East at 8 AM started the work 18 ships
in sight spoke the Big B. B. then saw
my ship with Bunk down

Thursday Sept 29th
To day strong Breef from
West employed in towing down the oil

Friday Sept 30th
To day fuk Breef from
West up along the East of the ice
the 10th Mer in sight Barking

Saturday Oct 1st Lat 71.00 Long 112.00
To day fuk Breef
from N. East went at the ship's side
right over the Mon Baker & Belvedere
take whals

Sunday Oct 2nd Lat 70.50 Long 110.35
To day fuk Breef
from S. West with snow squalls
from S. West spoke the Sepoy and Grey
at 10 AM raised a whale hauled
& saw boat struck him & turned him
up at 11 1/2 took him along side & finished
cutting at 4 PM saw the sail
