Monday April 10th Lat 58.41 Long 176.15
 This day fresh Breeze
 from S.W. at steering N.W. by N.W.
 West saw one sail going the same

Tuesday April 11th Lat 60.27 Long 177.30
 This day begins with
 fresh Breeze from S.W. at steering
 N.W. at 10 A.M. wind hauled
 to South at steering West saw the
 Ice latter part wind hauled to S
 and I began on the S gale at
 four P.M. have the ship the heading
 the South under lower Tapsails
 at 7 wind shifted under to S.W.
 broadened and I hauled S. at
 two sail run
