Sunday June 13th

This day light
Breeze from S West with foggy
Ship in scattering ice trying
to make the N East

Wednesday June 14th

This day light Breeze
from S West with foggy & rain
worked out to the N East through
the ice

Thursday June 15th

This day light Breeze
from S West clearing to North & East
among skating ice at
2 P.M. sighted the land in company
with the N Light & W Myers

Friday June 16th

To day fresh Breeze
from S West at 6 A.M. anchored at
East head of Plummer Bay found the winter
arched there the Horatia at anchor the Myers
& Light Roverie came in & the Bear & Karlak
& sailed again at 6 1/2 P.M. the Hunter got off
again

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26, 1889

Saturday June 17th

To day calm at anchor
waiting for Breeze the go East the
Bear sailed at 4 P.M. took the anchor
& went out nearly calm at 9 P.M.
got light Breeze from N East

Sunday June 18th

To day light Breeze
from N East thick foggy off
the Bear at 11 P.M. closed the anchor
off Indian Point the Horatia & Light
& Bear Myers & Schooner at anchor

Monday 19th

At anchor off Indian
Point trading with the natives
some ships here the Schooner sailed
