To day light Baffling
winds from Eastward off St. Lawrence
Island at 6 P.M. the East end of Point
bearing East the Horatio & Berg Naps
off shore the Schooner Rosario at Anchor

Thursday June 22nd
To day fresh Breeze
from N. S. West to S. West with thick
fog, passed the West end of St. Lawrence
Island then steered S. S. E. at 10 all
sail set latter part Breeze on took in
light sails saw the Horatio

FRIDAY, JUNE 28, 1889

Friday June 23rd
To day fresh Breeze
from S. West with thick fog, steering
S. S. E. & S. East at 7 1/2 A.M. passed
several large pieces of Ice

Saturday June 24th Lat 60 26 Long 170 on
To day wind from S.W.
to West & with thick fog steering
S. by East caught 7 Codfish

Sunday June 25th
To day light Breeze South
to S. S. East heading to S. East by East
thick fog, caught 4 Codfish saw
a Furball

Monday June 26th
To day light Breeze with
fog from South heading to S. East
