Bbs James Arnold from Kodiak
no Whales saw the Brig Perry Edwards

from South heading on different
tracks

Monday July 3rd
To day thick foggy
wind from South

Tuesday July 4th Lat 57.35 Long 170 25
To day fresh breeze from
6 AM the fog cleared up saw the
Island of St Paul heading S S West
about 10 miles saw the James Arnold
& Brig saw her with two boats
down at 11 headed the West & steamed N.E.
East at 2 1/2 PM saw a whole turn flukes
called it Right Whale
