Wednesday July 5th
To day strong Breeze from S West side of the
v. Cut and at 2 P.M. shifted to
wind heading to South West Limbark

Thursday July 6th
This light Breeze from
South with Fog heading M S M
at 10 P.M. Tacked to East and
one Limbark

Friday July 7th
This day fresh Breeze
from S S East with rain at
8 A.M. steered to by West until
12 M shifted to wind heading East

Saturday July 8th Lat 58.50 Long 170.20
To day begins with thick
fog at 11 A.M. wind hauled to S West
steering off S S East spoke the Bk Stamboul
& James Arnold

TUESDAY, JULY 2, 1889

Sunday July 9th
To day fresh Breeze
from S West with fog and at 11
saw the Island of St Paul being
South steered off by S West until
noon then hauled to and saw three
Sail

Monday July 10th
To day strong Breeze
from S West with fog saw the Jones
Arnold

Tuesday July 11, Lat 57 or Long 168.47
This day fresh Breeze from
N N West first part foggy at 10 A.M. cleared
up and saw the Jones Arnold with
Barks down at 1 P.M. we raised 2 Right
whales covered four Barks but the Jones
Arnold Barks struck & started over
unhappily chased until 6 P.M. then gave them
up when going to S West the Spratly got
her whale saw the B. Bilow & Hick & Handley
