To day strong Breeze
from S West at 8 A.M. noble ship
heading N West to N.W. West at 8
P.M. were to South & our 2 macks

Thursday July 27th Lat 57.45 Long
To day strong Breeze
from N.S. West heading N.W. West

Friday July 28th Lat 57.05 Long 168.20
To day fresh Breeze from
West laying in light tack saw
the Bk Mars & Bounding Belieu
