Saturday July 29th Lat 57.20 Long 168.37
To day fresh Breeze
from S West hauled to S East
at noon raised a Right Whale
at 1 lowered 4 Boats. Three Boats
went on to him but did not
get fast whole went to the windward
shook the nose the Boatsmen follow
in sight latter part blowed on to
a gale

Sunday July 30th Lat 57.35 Long 168.10
This day moderate gale
from S East with rain. Laying
on different tacks not anything
seen at

Monday July 31st
To day strong
Breeze with rain from S East at
8 P.M. steered off to West not
anything seen

MONDAY, JULY 8, 1889

Tuesday Aug 1st Lat 58.30 Long 170.41
To day begins with fresh
Breeze from N West latter hauled
to N West not anything seen

Wednesday Aug 2nd Lat 59.34 Long 167.45
To day fresh Breeze
from N West two N West on different
tacks not anything seen

Thursday Aug 3rd
To day fresh Breeze
from N West heading S East at 5
A.M. sighted the Island of Nunivak
bearing N East at 8 P.M. tacked
to West at noon tacked back latter
part wind light latter got a Breeze
from South steered to West
