from S East steering S W by West
for East Cape but at 2 PM sighted
the land for East Cape stood in
for it 11 PM then tacked thick
foggy

Sunday Aug 13th
To day light
Breeze from S East foggy by spells
at 8 AM clear in the land
the West of East Cape round
Canoe came off shore and trading
died out to calm at 2 PM
light air from North

Monday Aug 14th
To day Calm &
thick foggy at 3 PM got breeze
from E S E steered N East

FRIDAY, JULY 12, 1889

Tuesday Aug 15th
light Breeze from E S E
heading N East at 1 PM sighted the
land Cape Lisburne

Wednesday Aug 16th Lat 69.38 Long 164.54
To day fresh Breeze from
N N West heading N East the land in
sight at 10 PM wind hauled to N E
tacked heading N N West got 30 Ducks

Thursday Aug 17th Lat 20.45 Long 164.07
To day fresh Breeze
from N East the N N East heading
N N West at 8 PM tacked heading
East

Friday Aug 18th
To day strong Breeze
from N East with foggy & rain saw
the land
