on different tracks not any thing
seen

Wednesday Aug 30th
To day fresh Breeze
East laying on different tracks foggy
most of the time now two
other Barks

Thursday Aug 31st Lat 71-10 Long 112-35
To day light Breeze
from S. East heading N. West
foggy all day

Friday Aug Sept 1st
To day thick foggy
& nearly calm

Saturday Sept 2nd
To day moderate
Breeze with foggy by spells from S. East
saw 3 different ships among the Thorator
& another light. Mr. Boyles cruising
along the Ice
