clear & nearly calm heading
to the South. Later got a Breeze
from N.E. at steady S.S.W. at

To day fresh breeze from
N.E. at game with S. Barker of Allen
& S. Larka at noon come in foggy

Friday Sept 22nd Lat 71.30 Long 172.58
To day light Breeze
from N.E. at foggy part the time
spoke the Steamer Thresher & Schooner
Rosario

Saturday Sept 23rd Lat 71.40 Long 170.46
To day strong Breeze
from East heading N.E. at 6 sail
seen

Sunday Sept 24th No Chs
To day light Breeze
from N.E. at steering S.S.W. at
6 P.M. lifted to avoid heading E.
S.E. at Weather part nearly calm
