To day fresh Breeze
from N. N. West heading North
saw seven sail

Wednesday Oct 4th for Obs
To day fresh Breeze
from West on different tacks saw
3 sail

Thursday Oct 5th Lat 71.25 Long 171
To day strong Breeze
from S. West heading N. N. West
2 P.M. tacks spoke the ship Knobs
3 other sail in sight

Friday Oct 6th Lat 70.55 Long 171.45
To day wind fresh from
N. E. to S. West at 10 A.M. saw a
Whale in windward only saw him
and raining saw two steamers &
one sailing ship at 8 P.M. breeze on
strong from N. N. West under cover
of clouds & St. James
