

SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 1889

Monday April 16th Lat 55.40 Lon Obs
To day strong Breeze from
N East until 2 PM when it shifted
then hauled to West heading NW
N to N by West but nothing seen

Tuesday April 17th No Obs
To day fresh Breeze
from West heading NW

Wednesday April 18th Lat 58.30 Long 129.23
This day light Breeze
from S West steering NW at
noon shifted and started to Steer
N steering NW by N by N put out
the Boats & went down the
Ice Top gallant yard at 9 PM
Breeze up from East at 10.30
stopped steaming

MONDAY, AUGUST 19, 1889

Thursday April 19th Lat 61.10 Long 128.06 East
To day strong Breeze
from E by E steering NW by N by N at
at 10 AM sighted the Ice at 11
steered off the west side and
ice then headed on for NW
through ice and ice got into it
and I lost much water lower
Lapels blowing quite fresh

Friday April 20th No Obs
This day blowing S Gale
from N East laying along to leeward
of the I

Saturday April 21st Lat 61.55 Long 126.40
To day fresh Breeze
from N East worked in to
the head and then fresh every
thing & started to Steer NW
Eastward away and set the
head in sight from Cape Smyth
to the Eastward saw a Bark at
2 PM stopped steaming & set lower
Lapels for night
