

SATURDAY, AUGUST 24, 1889

Friday May 4th Lat
To day light Breeze
Sun Westward lots of young Ice around
worked to South some at 4 P.M.
saw a bowhead and many row the
harbour with boats down the other ships
in sight

Saturday May 5th Lat 61 30 Long 177 12
To day light Breeze from
East steamed to West until noon
then hauled to north under sail
the Steamers Oca & Baluga steaming
to South the harbour & Adenander in
sight saw several Grampuses

Sunday May 6th Lat 61 35 Long 176 55
To day light Breeze
ships at 8 A.M. started to Steer to
N. East steamed until 10 got into
a hole & layed in it the remainder
of the day the harbour & land in sight

SUNDAY, AUGUST 25, 1889

Monday May 7th Lat 61 34 Long 177 29 E
To day light Breeze in slack
Ice at 4 1/2 started to Steer to N. East
at 7 Ice closed up stopped steaming saw
Grampuses & harbour & land

Tuesday May 8th Lat Long 17
To day light Breeze from South
at 3 A.M. steamed to N. East until six
at noon Steamed to North into clear water at
Wednesday May 9th 4 P.M. made sail
steered to N. E. at 11 P.M. passed Cape
Barrow

Wednesday May 9th off N. W. Cape Thaddeus
in clear water saw the Banks Mander
Jensen & Myrthoff Tatum Star Thrasher
& Shawach

Thursday May 10 started to Steer
to North with the other two Steamers
