Friday May 18th

At Indiana Point

get any farther north made the ship
port to the ice the Grasher in
the ice at 4 P.M. let go the ice
& went into a hole

THURSDAY, AUGUST 29, 1889

Monday May 21st

To day Fulk Breezy
from N East at 9 A.M. made ship fast
to the ice at 1 P.M. let go the ice
& steamed to north went up port north
head & made fast to the ice

Tuesday May 22nd

To day Fulk Breezy
from north ship fast to ice at 6 A.M.
The ice began to come in had to
let go the ice & steam to South
off North head & let the ship lay
employed in stowing coal in
the main hold saw two sail
to Eastward.

Wednesday May 23rd

To day Fulk Breezy
from north under sail heading up to
East Cape saw Devil fish
