the anchor & went to the South
of the Point & anchored again
at 6 P.M. the foggy cleared again

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 1889

Monday June 11th
To day strong
Breeze from East at anchor took
the anchor & started for St. Lawrence
Island with the barack upon the
Alexander bound for Ourslopes
at 12 P.M. anchored at St. Lawrence
Island

Tuesday June 12th
To day strong
Breeze with fog from the North
at anchor at St. Lawrence Island

Wednesday June 13th
To day blowing
gale from East at anchor at
St. Lawrence Island Island ship
dressed and hat to dry second
anchor the barack hulk
