

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 1889

Tuesday July 10th
To day strong
Breeze from S East for different
talks working in north the
land in sight South Head
& the land to south of it
at 5 1/2 PM took in sail & started
steaming to north at 11 1/2 anchored
under South Head in 6 fathoms water

Wednesday July 11th
To day fresh Breeze
from north at anchor under South
Head the Bear came in from
Port Clarence & anchored at
11 left again at 1 PM we took
the anchor & started for East
Cape under steam at 10 PM
Anchored under East Cape
in ten fathoms water

Steamed 54 hours from Oumalooka

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1889

Thursday July 12th
To day blowing from
north with rain at anchor under
East Cape at 9 AM the Bear came
in & anchored

Friday July 13th
To day fresh Breeze
from N West at anchor at
East Cape the Bear due at anchor
saw Killis & Walrus

Saturday July 14th
To day begins
with fresh Breeze & rain from N
West at anchor at East Cape

Sunday July 15th
at 10 1/2 AM got at
Breeze from East took the anchor
& started up through the straits
under steam at 6 PM Breeze
up from S East made sail & started
steaming steering N by East
