

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 1889

Monday July 16th To day strong Breeze from S. East at 11 1/2 AM passed Point Hope then steamed N. by Mt at 4 PM passed Cape Lisburne, saw three Schooners at Angah at point Hope saw a Bork off shore saw some ice the north of Lisburne, saw three Barks & a Brig steaming N. N. East after passing Lisburne

Tuesday July 17th To day at 3 AM wind died out took in sail & started steaming, passed three Barks at noon passed Cape Hope quite a lot of ice steering along the land at 8 1/2 PM tried up the ice off Maniwikah Inlet found the Moverah Gherker Baluga & Freeman Oca again all stuck up to the ice wind from N. East

Steamed 79 hours

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 1889

Wednesday July 18th To day light Breeze from N. East at 2 AM let go the ice & steamed to north & made fast to the ice of Point Belcher ice hard on the N. Point

Thursday July 19th To day light Breeze from N. East at 6 AM let go the ice & steamed up off Point Franklin & made fast again the Baylies & Alexander came in from South

Friday July 20th To day strong Breeze from N. East made fast to ice off Point Franklin at 10 PM let go the ice & started for Cape Smith had the work through and ice all the other steamers in sight
