from north with some fog. Ste
made fast to ice painted the
Ship outside the other ships in night

Friday Aug 31st
To day breeze from
N East ship fast to ice finished
the painting

Saturday Aug 4th
To day fresh breeze
with fog & rain from N East
at 2 AM had to fleet the ship
around the ice at 9 PM saw
one of the failing ships to the
West looked like she was ashore

Sunday Aug 5th
To day fresh breeze with
fog from N East at 1 PM left for the
ice started to East went about 15
miles would not get any further the
ship we saw ashore proved to be the
Remder jammed on to a shoal by ice

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 1889

Monday Aug 6th
To day light breeze
with fog from north all the Steamers
hid up to the ice the Salonds of
Lagers Reef in night to South the
Jenni came in night

Tuesday Aug 7th
To day nearly calm
Ship tied up to the ice the Ocean &
Trucker & Hound fluted to west and

Wednesday Aug 8th
This day winds from
all points of the compass with thick
fog ship fast to the ice

Thursday Aug 9th
To day light breeze
from north with fog ship tied up to
the ice
