

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 1889

Wednesday Aug 22nd
 Today nearly Calm
 at 7 AM we north of Palau Island
 then steered by Eastward under
 single Bell at 7 PM turned back
 the West saw nothing quite a lot of Sea

Thursday Aug 23rd
 Today light Breeze
 from West passed the Palau Islands
 at 3 AM then steered for Thershal
 Island under single Bell at 6 1/2
 PM came to anchor at Thershal Island
 went ashore to get the news the
 friends of Mary I. Thershal there at
 8 PM took the Anchor & started
 out again out the Balina Warwhal
 wharf, going in we steered off
 to the by compass from the Island

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 1889

Friday Aug 24th
 Today nearly Calm
 at 2 AM stopped Steaming & made
 all sail heading to the West all
 the rest of the Steamer in sight
 at 12 M started steaming to West
 at 4 1/2 stopped made all sail saw
 the Alexander with Boats down

Saturday Aug 25th
 Today fresh Breeze
 from East to S West ship under
 full heading to East spoke the Koubuk
 at 10 five Whales this morning at 4
 PM came on foggy & died out Calm
 the other Steamer in sight

Sunday Aug 26th
 Today fresh Breeze
 from East at 6 1/2 AM started
 the Steamer to East the Breeze Koubuk
 and I saw put on sight saw
 the land
