Friday Sept 7th

To day fresh Breeze
from North at 12 o'clock a whole
load of Bait at 1st the L.B. plucked
& turned him up at 1¹/₂ took him
along side & hooked on & got dinner
at 12¹/₂ commenced for cut at 1¹/₄ to 4
finished thick inner most of
the time saw the Teacher at 4¹/₂
made sail & headed to North East

Saturday Sept 8th

To day light Breeze
from North East saw the Teacher & M.D.
Hume take Whales saw the Beluga M.
Boyle's & Freeman with Boats down
we lowered twice for Whales without
success

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6, 1889

Sunday Sept 9th off Cape Delhomme

To day light Breeze from
North East at 8 A.M. came in thick
fog at 1 P.M. cleared up starting steaming
to North until 2¹/₂ P.M. spoke the Teacher
& Beluga & M.M. Boyle's saw the wharf
M.D. Hume & Freeman

Monday Sept 10th

To day light Breeze
from North East at 6 A.M. started off
thick fog at 3 P.M. lifted
the wind spoke the Hume with 5 Whales
this noon

Tuesday Sept 11th

To day nearly calm
& thick fog at 4 P.M. fog cleared &
got Breeze from North East spoke the
Beluga wharf M.D. Hume & M.M. Boyle's
took mail for them
