Saturday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> To day begins  
with light breeze from West  
died out nearly calm at noon  
breeze up from East N East  
& showed them hauld to E  
S East & rain heading to  
South saw 9 sail two Baring

Sunday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> Lat 71 20 Long 172 15  
To day strong breeze  
from S E to East at 3<sup>1/2</sup> P.M.  
rain at Barhead covered the  
Boats without success saw  
four sail

Monday Sept 24<sup>th</sup> Lat 71.40 Long 171 00  
To day fresh breeze  
from E to S E at 7 saw 7 sail  
latter thick foggy

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12, 1889

Tuesday Sept 26<sup>th</sup> Lat 72 40 Long 172 10  
To day fresh breeze from  
N East thick fog at 2 P.M. cleared up  
saw the sail & one sail more ship to South

Wednesday Sept 26<sup>th</sup> Lat 75.50 Long 171.30  
To day light breeze  
from E N East saw the Norway sharing  
& Mahale at 2 P.M. spoke her saw another  
Boat

Thursday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>  
To day nearly calm  
spoke the Andrew Hicks & Norway

Friday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> Lat 71.10  
To day nearly calm  
steaming steering S E by South at 1 P.M.  
made sail & stopped steering heading  
to S E latter part breeze up from North  
the Norway in sight
