To day strong
Breeze from N.W. Wind heading
N. East at 12 noon ship heading
West under lower Topsails
employed in Boiling at 3 P.M.
suddenly a Gale stopped Boiling
smoking most of the time
not anything seen at 7 P.M.
Cooled down

Saturday Oct 6th Lat 21 30 Long 169 30
This day nearly
a Gale from N.W. Wind heading N. East
at 12 noon ship heading N.W. East
under lower Topsails & stern Staysails
saw one sail

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 1889

Sunday Oct 7th No Obs
To day nearly Calm
at 3 P.M. got Breeze from N. East
steered N.W. East at 7 P.M. luffed
to Wind heading N.W. East at day
light started the works at 7 P.M.
finished Boiling the California
in sight

Monday Oct 8th Lat 21 30 Long 170 31
To day fresh Breeze
& very cold from N.W. Wind heading
to West at 1 P.M. raised a
Barkhead covered the Bark the
Bark got nearly on the line which
went to windward. sail set at 6 P.M.

Tuesday Oct 9th No Observations
To day fresh Breeze from
N.W. Wind at 8 P.M. raised Barkhead
covered the Bark at 10 P.M. Bark struck
afternoon got slightly stove turned
him up at 11 P.M. struck him along
side got dinner & began to eat
at 3 P.M. finished saw two Barks
the California in sight
