

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17, 1889

Wednesday Oct 16<sup>th</sup>  
To day fresh Breeze  
from N to West to N.W. Wind at 2 AM  
we were ship headed to East anchorage  
in Boston at 10 PM finished  
speaking the Alice Knowles at  
6 PM and ship to West

Thursday Oct 17<sup>th</sup> at 71.114  
To day strong Breeze  
from N.W. to West with snow  
squalls at 8 AM we ship heading  
from N.W. East to E.N. East  
at 6 PM we ship heading West  
not anything seen

Friday Oct 18<sup>th</sup>  
To day strong Breeze  
from N.W. East to E.N. East  
heading to N.W. at 4 PM came  
to gathering Ice we ship heading  
S.E.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18, 1889

Saturday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>  
To day strong Breeze  
with snow from N.W. East at 8 AM  
in young Ice for as we could see  
to N.W. East & West we ship &  
steered at S.E. East at 3 PM rounded  
& had 12 fathoms hauled to S.E. East  
& steered so through the night

Sunday Oct 14<sup>th</sup>  
To day strong Breeze  
from N.W. East at 10 AM we got Obs  
found we were in west of purpose we  
thought kept the ship up East tried  
to get hold of Point Hope but it  
was moving all the time steered East  
until 4 PM then kept off S.E. East  
under all sail at 5 PM started  
steaming at 9 steered S.E. by 8 1/2 South
