

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 1889

Monday Oct 15<sup>th</sup>

To day wind light from N.W. to N.E. under all sail & steam steering S.E. by S. until 8 AM then steered S.S. East at 10 AM sighted the Land East Cape shortly after saw the Diomedes bearing S by East at 11 steered South by Compass at 4 1/2 Diomedes Island bearing E. N. E then steered S by W. 1/2 West at 6 began to breeze fresh East at 8 P.M. put on all sail & steam went 65 miles then steered S by West Breezing on all the time at 12 blowing fresh from East took in light Sails

Tuesday Oct 16<sup>th</sup>

To day begins with strong breeze & thick smoke steering S by East steering S by West at 8 AM blowing a gale took in fore sail & jib thought we were by Indian Point then steered S.S. West to before St. Lawrence Island at 8 AM covered away S. B. Back & forward Davits & Berries out for clean & hit it getting heavy sea running at under low Tides & S. by East & Jangle Bill at noon stop at 2 P.M. now back & wind

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20, 1889

Came out to West shore of the Fossils & started steaming again steering South latter part met much wind but heavy swell from S West at 4 P.M. now St. Lawrence & Oday being & etc

Wednesday Oct 17<sup>th</sup> Lat 62.00 Long 173.28

To day begins with calm steered S by East under steam at 3 P.M. got breeze from South to S.S. West made sail & stop steaming heading from S. East to E.S. East heavy swell from S West

Thursday Oct 18<sup>th</sup> Lat 61.12 Long 171.54

To day light breeze from South at 9 AM nearly calm started steaming & steered S.E. until 3 P.M. then S by East, saw one seal employed in scraping Bark

Friday Oct 19<sup>th</sup> Lat 59.25 Long 171.24

To day mostly calm first part steaming till 10 AM stop & made sail steering S.S. East employed in scraping Bark
