WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 1889

Journal kept on board Bk California.

Wednesday Mar 6<sup>th</sup>

To day fresh trades from NE by East at 12 M took the anchor and took our departure from Guam; with forty men all told, and steered N by West.

Thursday Mar 7<sup>th</sup>. Lat 15.55 N Long 143.27 E.

Today fresh trades from E N E steering N 1/2 West. Employed in rigging boat in the house. Nothing seen.

Friday Mar 8<sup>th</sup> Lat 18.20 N Long 142.16 E.

Today fresh trades from E N E steering North. Employed in coiling new lines, and making fore stay sail.

Saturday Mar 9<sup>th</sup>. Lat 20.00 N Long 142.16 E.

Today light winds from East. steering from N to N by E. Gave out clothes to crew.

Sunday Mar 10<sup>th</sup>. Lat 20.50 N Long 142.08 E.

Today light winds from East. steering N by E. Latter part calm. Saw black fish.

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THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 1889

Monday Mar 11<sup>th</sup>. Lat 21.08 N Long 142.00 E.

Today begins with a calm. at 10 am light breeze from N N E to N E. heading N W to N N W. Bent new flying jib. Saw black fish.

Tuesday Mar 12<sup>th</sup> Lat 22.15 N Long 141.52 E

Today moderated breeze from E N E. heading North. Nothing of note transpired.

Wednesday Mar 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 22.55 N Long 142.16 E.

Today light breeze from SE to West. Steering N by East. At 12 M saw black fish. Covered boats without success.

Thursday Mar 14<sup>th</sup>. Lat 24.09 N Long 142.40 E.

Today moderate breeze from W to N W. Steering N by E until six PM. then headed N. N E. Nothing seen.

Friday Mar 15<sup>th</sup>. Lat 24.50 N Long 142.51 E.

Today light breeze from the West. Steering North. Saw fin backs, and black fish.
