TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 1889

Saturday Apr 6th. Lat 42.16 N. No Observation.

Today begins with a light breeze from the South with fog. At 10 a.m. wind hauled to S.W. and cleared. Steered N.E. At 6 p.m. wind hauled to the north. Heading to Eastward. Saw a fin back.

Sunday Apr 7th. Lat 42.23 N. Long 148.46 E.

Today begins with a strong breeze from N.W. Ship on different tack. Latter part wind light. Heading N.E. Saw several fin backs.

Monday Apr 8th. Lat 43.00 N. Long 148.34 E.

Today begins with a fresh breeze from the South. Steering North until 12 m, then wind hauled S.E. luffed to the wind, heading S.S.W. At 2 p.m. raised two Right Whales. At 4 p.m. lowered four boats without success. Whales working to the South.

Tuesday Apr 9th. No Observation.

Today begins with fresh breeze from the S.E. and rain. At 7 a.m. saw a Right Whale on rising. At noon blowing a moderate gale. At 5 p.m. wind hauled to the West and blowed quite fresh. Furlled fore top sail. Ship on starboard tack.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 1889

Wednesday Apr 10th. No Observation.

Today begins with a strong breeze from N.W. Ship on different tack. Latter part wind to the North. Saw fin backs.

Thursday Apr 11th. Lat 42.45 N. Long 148.38 E.

Today begins with a fresh breeze from the N.E. At 6 1/2 a.m. raised a Right Whale. At 9 a.m. lowered four boats, shortly after the bow boat capsized, frightened the whale, it went to the windward. At 10 a.m. took the boats up. Ship working to the windward. At sun down saw another Right Whale and several fin backs.

Friday Apr 12th. Lat 42.50 N. Long 148.28 E.

Today begins with a calm, at 10 a.m. got a light breeze from the West. Steered N by W. At 2 p.m. raised two Right Whales to the windward. At 4 p.m. lowered four boats without success. At 7 p.m. took the boats up, whales still in sight. Whales working to the N.E.

Saturday Apr 13th. Lat 42.50 N. Long 149.26 E.

Today begins with a fresh breeze from the S.W. At 5.30 a.m. raised two Right Whales going to S.E. At 7 a.m. lowered four boats. W. B. went on and darted but did not get fast. Then whales went to the N.E. quick. At 2.30 p.m. took the boats up. At 4 p.m. lowered again. Whales went to the windward. At 5.30 took up boats again.
