 Today begins with a fresh
 breeze from E. S. E. with fog. At 4 PM fog
 cleared breeze on strong from the East.
 At 7 PM wore ship to the North.

Thursday Apr 25th. No Observation.
 Today begins with a fresh gale
 from E. S. E. Heading N. E. Blimed away
 the fore top mast stay sail, and lurch
 Main top sail, weather side. then gone
 winged it. Latter part unbecom-
 lent another, weather more moderate and
 thick fog.

Friday Apr 26th. No Observation.
 Today begins with a strong
 breeze from the East, with fog. At 10 AM
 wind hauled to the N. W. Heading S. W.

Saturday Apr 27th. Lat 43.25 N. Long 148.20 E.
 Today nearly calm. At 6 PM got
 a light breeze from S. W. Steered S. E. by South.
 Employed in fetching water. Saw fin backs.

Sunday Apr 28th. No Observation.
 Today light breeze from N. N. W.
 Steering S. E. At 12 M luffed to the wind
 heading West. Fog most of the day.

Monday Apr 29th. Lat 42.48 N. Long 148.56 E.
 Today fresh breeze from N. N. W.
 to N. E. Heading from West to N. N. W. Foggy
 at intervals. Saw fin backs.

Tuesday Apr 30th. Lat 42.50 N. Long 148.43 E.
 Today strong breeze from the N. E.
 with squalls of snow. At 6 AM raised a Right
 Whale, lowered three boats. W Boat struck and
 drained, whale went to the windward. At 10 AM
 took up the boats.

Wednesday May 1st. Lat 42.40 N. No Obs.
 Today begins with a calm
 At 1 PM got a breeze from the South. Steered
 N. W. until 5.30 PM, then luffed to the wind
 heading W. S. W. At 7.30 PM wore ship to the
 East and shortened sail. Saw fin backs.
