Wednesday June 12th Lat 57.22 N. Long 167.26 W.
 Today fresh breeze from the S.E. to East.
 Heading from E. N. East to N. N. East. Saw -
 Devil Fish and Killis.

Thursday June 13th No Observation.
 Today strong breeze from the N. East -
 with rain and snow. Heading N. N. West.
 At 12 M. more ship, heading S.E. by E. East.

Friday June 14th No Observation.
 Today light breeze from the N. East -
 with rain and fog. Ship on different tack.

Saturday June 15th Lat 58.12 N. Long 169.25 W.
 Today moderate breeze from the
 N. North. West. Heading West. At 2 P.M. steered
 off South by East. Fog most of the day.

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WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 1889

Sunday June 16th 57.38 N. Long 169.35 W.
 Today light breeze from N. West.
 Ship on different tack. Nothing seen. Fog.

Monday June 17th 57.28 N. Long 169.50 W.
 Today moderate breeze from the
 S. West with fog. Ship on different tack.

Tuesday June 18th 57.38 N. Long 169.30 W.
 Today light breeze from the S. West
 with fog most of the day. At 6 A.M. came to
 ice, seemed to be quite a body, being foggy
 could not see how much there was. Wore ship
 and steered E. S. East.

Wednesday June 19th Lat 56.26 N. Long 168.25 W.
 Today fresh breeze from the
 West South West. Heading South. Saw one
 Fin back.

Thursday June 20th No Observation
 Today light breeze from the S. S. West -
 with some rain and fog. Heading from N. West to West.
 Spoke Cutter Perry. Caught a number of Cod fish.
