THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 1889

Friday June 21st. Lat 56.40 N. Long 169.00 W.
Today light breeze from the South
with fog at intervals. Employed in fishing all
day. Hauled about three barrels of fish.

Saturday June 22nd. Lat 57.00 N. Long 168.30 W.
Today moderate breeze from the
East to N East. Heading from N. N East to
N. N West. Fog most of the day. Saw a few
Finbacks. Caught about a barrel of Cod fish.

Sunday June 23rd No Observation.
Today light breeze from the North
steering West by South. Saw a Steamer called
it the Jeanie, steering to the North. Saw Killers.

Monday June 24th No Observation.
Today light breeze from the N West.
Heading to the N. N East. Thick fog. Employed
in fishing.

Tuesday June 25th Lat 56.42 N. Long 168.55 W.
Today moderate breeze from W N West.
Thick fog most of the day.

Wednesday June 26th Lat 57.26 N. Long 167.58 W.
Today moderate breeze from the West-S West
with some fog. On different tacks. Saw Killers.

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FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 1889

Thursday June 27th. Lat 57.04 N. Long 168.04 W.
Today fresh breeze from the West,
to W S West. Ship on different tacks.
Saw one Humpback.

Friday June 28th Lat 57.12 N. Long 168.50 W.
Today fresh breeze from the S S West.
Steered N N West until 12 M, then luffed to the wind,
heading West. Saw Finbacks.

Saturday June 29th No Observation.
Today fresh breeze from S by West,
with fog and rain. Ship on different tacks.

Sunday June 30th. No Observation.
Today moderate breeze from the South
with fog. Ship on different tacks.

Monday July 1st Lat 57.17 N. Long 168.08 W.
Today calm with fog most of
the day. Employed in scraping the bone.

Tuesday July 2nd No Observation.
Today strong breeze from the E
S East. Steering S West until 5 P M, then
luffed to the wind, heading N E by North.
Employed in washing bone.
