N West 1/2 North. The Alice Hunter and
Mermaid sailed also.Friday July 26th Lat 56.40 N. Long 168.41 W.Today moderate breeze from S. S. West.
Steering N W 1/2 North until 8 A.M. then steered
N by North. At 5 P.M. sighted the island St. George.Saturday July 27th No Observation.Today fresh breeze from the South.
with rain and fog. Heading East until 1 P.M.
then steered N. N. West until 5 P.M. then luffed
to the wind, heading West. Saw San Lucas.
