FRIDAY, DECEMBER 6, 1889

Thursday Aug 8th. Lat 62.45 N. Long 175.48 W.

Today moderate breeze from the North. Heading E. N. East. At 7 P.M., wind hauled N. West. Steered N. E. by North.

Friday Aug 9th Lat 62.46 N. Long 173.25 W.

Today nearly a calm.

Saturday Aug 10th No Observation.

Today fresh breeze from the South. Steering N. by East and N. E. by North. At 3 A.M. sighted St. Lawrence island bearing N. E. by N. For most of the day. At 7 P.M. the N. West point of St. Lawrence Island bearing S. by West. then steered W. by North.

Sunday Aug 11th No Observation.

Today begins with a strong breeze from the South with fog. At 10 A.M. wind hauled to the N. East. At 11 A.M. anchored South of Indian Point.

Monday Aug 12th No Observation.

Today light breeze from the S. West. At 9 A.M. took our departure from Indian Pt. Steered N. E. by N. and N. N. East.

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SATURDAY, DECEMBER 7, 1889

Tuesday Aug 13th Lat 65.13 N. Long 170.20 W.

Today light air from the South. Steering N. N. East. At 6 A.M. sighted the islands of Diomedes. At 7 P.M. islands bearing N. E. by N. $\frac{1}{2}$ North. East Cape bearing N. by East.

Wednesday Aug 14th No Observation.

Light breeze from the South. Steering N. N. East until 6 A.M., close to Diomedes Island, then steered N. N. West for East Cape. Two Canoes came off from E. Cape did some trading. At 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ M. kept off N. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. Saw Devil Fish!

Thursday Aug 15th Lat 67.50 N. Long 168.13 W.

Today moderate breeze from the S. East. Steered North $\frac{1}{2}$ W. until 8 A.M., then steered N. by E. At 1 P.M. sighted the land at the eastward of Pt. Hope.

Friday Aug 16th No Observation.

Today light breeze from the South. Steered N. by E. until 7 A.M. then steered N. N. East. At 10 A.M. passed Cape Lisburne. At 8 P.M. Cape Lisburne bearing S. by East. distant 20 miles.
