

1895. SATURDAY, DECEMBER 14, 1889

Sunday Sept 15th. Lat 70. 31 N.

Today begins with a fresh breeze from the W. S. West, steered N East until 1 P.M. when the wind hauled to the North. breezed up strong, heading E. N East. All the ships in sight. Saw some ice.

Monday Sept 16th. Lat 70. 55 N. Long 167. 55 W.

Today fresh breeze from the N. N. W. to W. S. West. Heaving from N E to N West. All the ships in sight.

Tuesday Sept 17th. Lat 71. 40 N. Long 168. 22 W.

Today strong breeze from the W. S. W. Ship on different tacks along the ice. All the ships except the Brig in sight.

Wednesday Sept 18th. Lat 71. 03 N. Long 169. 07 W.

Today begins with nearly a gale from the West. Ship on different tacks among scattering ice. Latter part wind moderate. Three ships in sight.

Thursday Sept 19th. Lat 70. 35 N. Long 168. 20 W.

Today strong breeze from the South. Ship on different tacks, along the ice. Three Barks in sight. Gammed the Steamer Uca.

1895. SUNDAY, DECEMBER 15, 1889

Friday Sept 20th Lat 70. 57 N. Long 168. 11 W.

Today moderate breeze from the S. S. E. to S. S. West. Ship on different tacks. Gammed the Nasarhal, Thrasher, and Mermaid. Three other ships in sight.

Saturday Sept 21st. No Observations.

Today light baffling wind, with fog and rain. Saw five sails.

Sunday Sept 22nd Lat 71. 15 N.

Today fresh breeze from the North. Ship on different tacks. Saw the A. Hicks with boats down. Saw one other sail and the ice.

Monday Sept 23rd. No Observations.

Today strong breeze from the N. West. At 9 A.M. steered off S. S. East until 2.30 P.M. along the ice, then luffed to the wind heading W. S. West. Five ships in sight.

Tuesday Sept 24th. Lat 70. 40 N. Long 171. 30 W.

Today fresh breeze from the N. W. to N. N. W. Ship on different tacks, among scattering ice. Saw four sails.
