FRIDAY, DECEMBER 20, 1889

Monday Oct-14th.

Today strong breeze from the North. Steering South by East. At 2.30 A.M. passed the island Diomedes, then steered South by West. At 8 A.M. came to ice, steering through scattering ice until 4 P.M. At 5.30 P.M. passed Indian Pt. then steered South by West.

Tuesday Oct-15th Lat 62.02 N. Long 172.30 W.

Today fresh breeze from the North. Steering South by West. At 2.30 P.M. passed the St. Lawrence island, then steered S.E. by South. Saw a few scattering pieces of ice.

Wednesday Oct-16th Lat 59.46 N. Long 170.51 W.

Today strong breeze from the N.West. Steering S.East by South, until 9 A.M., then steered S.East. At 7 A.M. sighted the island St. Matthew; south end bearing S.West by West.

Thursday Oct-17th

Today strong breeze from the N.West, with snow squalls. Steering South by East. At 10 A.M. sighted the island of St. Paul bearing South by East. At 2 P.M. passed the island

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SATURDAY, DECEMBER 21, 1889

Friday Oct-18th Lat 55.41 N. Long 171.04 W.

Today fresh breeze from N.East to West, with snow squalls. Steering South by East. Saw Fini backs.

Saturday Oct-19th Lat 53.47 N. Long 170.30 W.

Today begins with a fresh breeze from N.West to West. Steering South by East until 6.30 A.M., then had baffling winds from S.West to West. Heading from S.East to S. West. At 9 A.M. sighted the land bearing S.East by South; one of the Four Mountain islands, distant 60 miles.

Sunday Oct-20th Lat 52.56 N. Long 171.15 W.

Today moderate breeze from N.West to North. Steering S.West by South $\frac{1}{2}$ South for the 72 Pass. At 8 P.M. passed the island Amoukta then steered S.East by South 20 miles, then steered S.East by East.

Monday Oct-21st Lat 51.00 N. Long 169.51 W.

Today strong breeze from the North. Steering East by South. Heavy snow from the N.E.
