 Today strong breeze from the N. West.
 Steering East.

Monday Nov 4th Lat 39.45 N Long 129.58 W.
 Today fresh breeze from the South West
 with drizzle. Steering East. Washed Ship
 inside. Saw one sail.

Tuesday Nov 5th Lat 38.43 N. Long 126.46 W.
 Today fresh breeze from the West to
 North. Steering East until 4 PM when the
 wind hauled N East. Heading East, S East.
 Saw a four masted ship heading to westward.

Wednesday Nov 6th Lat 37.51 N. Long 125.10 W.
 Today moderate breeze from the
 N. N East to N West. Steering N East by East
 and East North East. Saw the sails.

Thursday Nov 7th
 Today light breeze from the N. N E
 to N West. Steering N E by East. At daylight Point
 Reyes in sight. At 5 PM between Pt Reyes and San Lorenzo
 then Steered East. At 6 PM took tug Sea Queen and was
 towed into San Francisco.
